

Reading Follett eBooks and Audiobooks

Follett eBooks put you in control of your reading experience. From any device, you can listen to an eBook, change font sizes, create notes and bookmarks, and jump to any page – in just a few clicks.



Destiny Discover

Here's a closer look at what you'll see when you click an icon in an eBook's header.

Main Menu

The Main Menu interface shows a list of options. Callouts point to the following items:

- Offline Access**: Save your eBook to read offline.
- Offline Content Library**: Access the eBooks you saved for offline reading.
- TABLE OF CONTENTS**: Browse chapter names and click to go directly to that place in the book.

Voice Options

The Voice Options interface shows settings for audio playback. Callouts point to the following items:

- SPEEDS**: Click the desired voice speed.
- HIGHLIGHT OPTIONS**: Select how/if you want text to be highlighted during playback.
- VOICES**: Use to change the narrator's voice (options vary based on the browser and device).

Display Options

The options you see depend on the format of the eBook.

The Display Options interface shows settings for the eBook's appearance. Callouts point to the following items:

- FONT**: Drag the slider, or click A- or A+ to decrease or increase the font size.
- PAGE LAYOUT**: Switch between single- and double-page views. Click Auto to return to the view set by the publisher.
- THEMES**: Click a color swatch to change the background and font color.
- ZOOM TO FIT BY**: Use to set the page size to the height or width of your display.










The Bookmark interface shows a list of saved pages. Callouts point to the following items:

Notes, Highlights and more

Select a portion of text you want to work with. A pop-up displays a number of options.

	 HIGHLIGHT	<p>Click to highlight the selected text. From the pop-up that appears, select a color.</p> 
	 NOTE	<p>Click to add a note to the selected text. To add a highlight to a note, select a color. Click SAVE.</p> 
	 PLAY	<p>Click to hear the current page read aloud.</p>
	 GOOGLE	<p>Click to search Google for the selected word or phrase. A list of 10 search results appears. Click a link to open it in a new page in your browser.</p>
	 DEFINE	<p>Click to look up the definition of the selected text. A list of definitions appears, including the source for the definition.</p>
	 SEARCH	<p>Click to search the eBook for the selected word. Click a search result to go to that page.</p>

Listening to Follett Audiobooks

You can listen to Follett Audiobooks online. Use navigation controls to adjust the audio speed, create bookmarks and set a sleep timer.




Here's a closer look at what you'll see if you click an icon in an audiobook's header.

Audio Speed




Drag the slider to decrease or increase the audio speed.

Bookmark



Click to add a bookmark so you can easily mark your place.

Sleep Timer



Drag the slider to set a time for stopping playback. If you select **End**, the audio stops at the end of the current chapter.
